PEI Right to Life Educational Bursary

Description

This award was conceived as a means of supporting a young woman from Prince Edward Island who has carried an unplanned pregnancy to term and wishes to further her education attending a post-secondary institution.

General Criteria

- The applicant must be a woman from Prince Edward Island who has had an unplanned pregnancy and carried the baby to term within the last five years of the current year and is under 30 years of age.
- The applicant must be enrolled in a post-secondary educational institution. Preference will be given to an applicant enrolled as a full-time student but part-time enrolment will also be considered.
- The applicant must demonstrate financial need.
- **Application deadline August 31** and can be submitted via email: **office@peiright2life.ca** or mail to: PEI Right to Life Association, PO Box 1988, Charlottetown, PE, C1A 7N7.
- Applicants will receive acknowledgement that their application has been received.
- Only the successful applicant will be notified at the end of the process.
- The award is \$2,000 and the funds will be released directly into the students account at their education institution by October 31.

The application package must include:

1. Completed application form
2. A personal statement outlining:
 - a. your decision to further your education following your pregnancy
 - b. what your future goals and aspirations are in relation to your studies
 - c. volunteer activities / community involvement you participate in
 - d. hobbies
 - e. why you need this financial support
3. Proof of acceptance to the post-secondary education institution you will be attending.
4. Two letters of endorsement.
